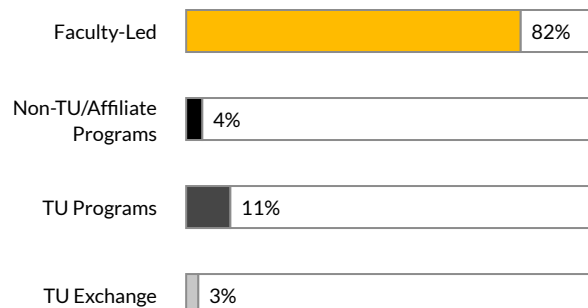

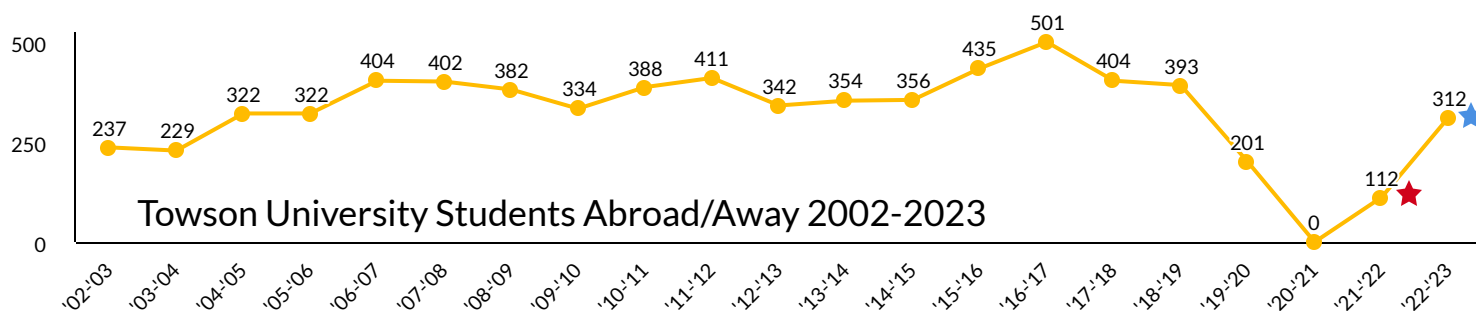

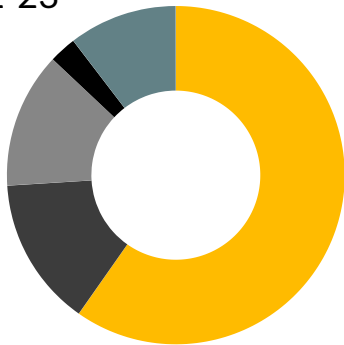

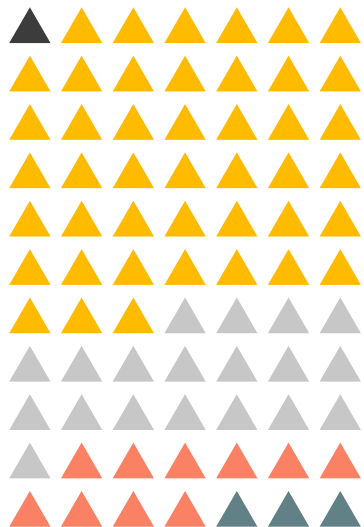
COFAC Study Abroad/Away by Ethnicity AY 2022-23

- Multi-racial (10.39%)

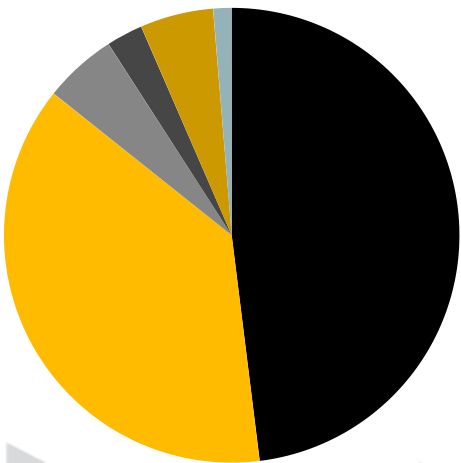
