## ELIGIBILITY

1. Must have completed 60 undergraduate credits.
2. Have a 3.0 or higher overall GPA.
3. Transfer students: Must have completed at least 12 credits at TU.
4. Admission to the program is limited and competitive. Students not admitted in the current semester can reapply for admission in future semesters.

## ADMISSION PROCESS

1. Students who meet the above requirements can apply by filling out the Accelerated B.S./M.S. Application Form and submitting it to the Business Analytics and Technology Management Department in Stephens Hall, Room 301 or by email to [supplychain@towson.edu](mailto:supplychain@towson.edu).
2. During their senior year, students must complete an online graduate application with the University Admissions Office. Admission to the graduate program is based on meeting the overall undergraduate GPA requirements of 3.0 and earning a "B" or better in each graduate course taken as part of the combined program.
