Discipline: HORN

General Information.

- The stated proficiencies below apply to all students taking lessons in the particular discipline.
- Level of difficulty for specific repertoire will be adjusted based upon the student's degree program.
- These proficiencies are the minimums for a passing grade in the discipline.
- Any student wishing to take 300-level applied lessons must successfully pass an upper division jury demonstrating the proficiencies as articulated below.

Proficiencies for a 1-credit lesson

Freshman Level

- ➤ All major and natural minor scales; C-G two octaves
- ➤ Kopprasch: 60 Etudes for Premier Horn
- Solo: Mozart Concerto No. 1 (K 447), Mason Jones' Solos for Horn

Sophomore Level

- ➤ All major and minor scales (three forms); C-G two octaves
- ➤ Kopprasch: 60 Etudes for Premier Horn
- ➤ Solo: Mozart Concerto No. 3 (K 412), Franz Strauss Concerto for Horn

<u>Upper Division Jury</u> (end of 2nd semester sophomore lessons)

> Proficiency in all material assigned in the first two years

Junior Level

- > All major and minor scales, two octaves
- ➤ Galley: 22 Studies for Horn
- Solo: Strauss Concerto No. 1 for Horn, Bernard Heiden Sonata for Horn
- > Junior recital (required based upon degree program)

Senior Level

- ➤ All major and minor scales, three octaves
- > Bitsch: 12 Etudes for Horn
- > Solo: Paul Hindemith Sonata for Horn, Dukas Villanelle
- Orchestral excerpts
- > Senior Recital (required based upon degree program)

Proficiencies for a 2-credit lesson

Freshman Level

- ➤ All major and natural minor scales; C-G two octaves
- > Kopprasch: 60 Etudes for Premier Horn
- ➤ Solo: Mozart Concerto No. 3 (K 447), Franz Strauss Concerto for Horn

Sophomore Level

- ➤ All major and minor scales (three forms); C-G two octaves
- ➤ Kopprasch: 60 Etudes for Premier Horn
- Solo: Mozart Concerto No. 3 (K 412), Beethoven Sonata, Op. 17

<u>Upper Division Jury</u> (end of 2nd semester sophomore lessons)

Proficiency in all material assigned in the first two years.

Junior Level

- > All major and minor scales, three octaves
- ➤ Galley: 22 Studies for Horn

- > Solo: Mozart Concerto No. 2, Hindemith Sonata for Horn and Piano
- > Orchestra excerpts
- > Junior Recital (required based upon degree program)

Senior Level

- ➤ All major and minor scales and arpeggios; three octaves
- > Reynolds: 48 Etudes
- > Solo: Mozart Concerto No. 4, Dukas Villanelle
- Orchestra excerpts
- > Senior recital (required based upon degree program)
