Proficiency Levels for Applied Lessons

Discipline: VOICE

General Information.

- The stated proficiencies below apply to all students taking lessons in the particular discipline.
- Level of difficulty for specific repertoire will be adjusted based upon the student's degree program.
- These proficiencies are the minimums for a passing grade in the discipline.
- Any student wishing to take 300-level applied lessons must successfully pass an upper division jury demonstrating the proficiencies as articulated below.

Proficiencies for a 1-credit lesson

Each semester the student will be required to prepare and perform one major and one minor scale at their jury.

Freshman Level – First Semester

- > Major and Minor Scale
- > 2 new and memorized selections

Freshman Level - Second Semester

- ➤ Major and Minor Scale
- > 2 new memorized selections
 - ◆ Must include 1 selection in a foreign language

Sophomore Level - First Semester

- ➤ Major and Minor Scale
- > 3-4 New and Memorize Selections
 - ◆ Must include 2 selections in a foreign language

Sophomore Year - Second Semester

- ➤ Major and Minor Scale
- ➤ 4-5 New and memorized selections
 - Must include selections in English, Italian, French and German languages
 - ◆ Music Education Majors ONLY: Must perform at least a 4-measure recitative

Upper Division Jury (end of 2nd semester sophomore lessons)

> Proficiency in all material assigned in the first two years

Junior Level

- ➤ Major and Minor Scale
- ➤ 4-5 New and memorized selections
 - ◆ Must include 3 selections in foreign languages
- > Junior recital (required based upon degree program)

Senior Level

- ➤ Major and Minor Scale
- ➤ 4-5 New and memorized selections
 - ◆ Must include 3 selections in foreign languages
- Senior Recital (required based upon degree program)

Proficiencies for a 2-credit lesson

Each semester the student will be required to prepare and perform one major and one minor scale at their jury.

<u>Freshman Level – First Semester</u>

- ➤ Major and Minor Scale
- > 3 New and memorized selections
 - ◆ 2 English or 1 English and 1 Italian

Freshman Level - Second Semester

- ➤ Major and Minor Scale
- > 4 New and memorized selections
 - ◆ At least 1 selection in a foreign language

<u>Sophomore Level – First Semester</u>

- ➤ Major and Minor Scale
- > 4-5 New and memorized selections
 - ◆ At least 1 selection in Italian and 1 selection in German or French

Sophomore Level - Second Semester

➤ Major and Minor Scale

BS Degrees:

- > 5 New and memorized selections plus a 16-measure recitative
 - Must include selections in English, Italian, French, and German languages

BM Degree:

- ➤ 6 New and memorized selections plus a 16-measure recitative
 - Must include selections in English, Italian, French, and German languages

<u>Upper Division Jury</u> (end of 2nd semester sophomore lessons)

> Proficiency in all material assigned in the first two years.

Junior Level

➤ Major and Minor Scale

BS Degrees:

- > 5 New and memorized selections
 - At least 4 selections in a foreign language that may include Latin, Russian, or Spanish

BM Degree:

- ➤ 6 New and memorized selections plus a 16-measure recitative
 - At least 4 selections in a foreign language that may include Latin, Russian, or Spanish
- > Junior recital (required based upon degree program)

Senior Level

Major and Minor Scale

BS Degrees:

- > 5 New and memorized selections
 - ◆At least 4 selections in a foreign language that may include Latin, Russian, or Spanish

BM Degree:

- ➤ 6 New and memorized selections plus a 16-measure recitative
 - ◆ At least 4 selections in a foreign language that may include Latin, Russian, or Spanish
- > Senior Recital (required based upon degree program)
