What is CSA?

• To support the recruitment of new *cyber talent* and the retention of current *highly skilled professionals* within the DoD cyber workforce.

 To enhance the national pipeline for the development of cyber personnel by providing grants to institutions of higher education.

Benefits (1/2)

• \$29,000 yearly stipend (undergraduate)

• \$34,000 yearly stipend (graduate)

- Job guarantee
 - Work for the DOD/NSA Agency

Benefits (2/2)

- Full coverage
 - Tuition
 - Health insurance
 - Mandatory fees

• \$1,000 yearly book allowance

• \$1,650 one-time laptop purchase

Obligations

Summer internship (paid)

- Job employment
 - Join a DoD/NSA agency with competitive salary and promotion
 - Must work the same number of years receiving the scholarship.

Eligibility

- Juniors / Seniors
 - Sophomores promoting to a Junior in Fall are eligible to apply

• Graduate students (MS or D.Sc.)

Requirements (1/2)

US Citizenship

Minimum GPA: 3.2 (undergrad) or 3.5 (grad)

- Security Clearance
 - Required for Federal employment

Requirements (2/2)

A strong commitment & responsibility

Must work for the DoD after graduation

• Back-out results in repayment of all scholarship money

Application Requirements (1/3)

Letters of recommendation

Minimum 2 letters

• Should be specific

Request them ASAP

Application Requirements (2/3)

Transcripts

• Official (electronic) transcripts recommended.

Request them ASAP

Application Requirements (3/3)

- Statement of purpose / competency
 - Strong motivation
 - Be honest, respectful, passionate and confident
 - Proof-read and revise your statements


