## **TU SAFETY ADVISORY: ON CAMPUS FIRST DEGREE ASSAULT**

### Incident Summary:

On **Wednesday, June 30, 2021** at approximately **10:32 AM**, the Towson University Police Department became aware of an **ON CAMPUS FIRST DEGREE ASSAULT** near the corner of Cross Campus Drive and Tower A Drive next to Glen Complex Tower A.

On Wednesday June 30, 2021 at approximately 10:15 AM, an unknown male driving a newer model silver in color SUV (unknown tag) pulled up to the victim, shouted a racial slur towards the victim, displayed a dark colored handgun and then sped away driving westbound on Cross Campus Drive towards Osler Drive.
