**Letters of Appeal should include the following:**

1. Name (First, Initial, Last)
2. Towson Student ID #
3. TU E-Mail address
4. Nature of Appeal (Withdrawal, Transfer Petition, GenEd/CORE Exception, etc.)
5. Course Name/Number/Section
6. Supporting Documentation (Medical, Legal, etc.)

**Appeal Letters:**

Letters must be written by the student, not a third party. They should be brief, concise, typed and include documentation (i.e. Medical documentation on letterhead including dates of treatment). Electronic submission via PDF is preferred. A sample of an appeal letter can be found at ASC Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's).
