- No more than 80% of class offerings can be during peak time
- At least 20% of class offerings must be during non-peak time
- Online courses are considered non-peak time
- Evening classes (starting 4pm or later) are considered non-peak
 - Classes starting during peak and ending in non-peak time (e.g. 3:30-4:45pm) are considered peak time
- Classes offered any time after 2:00pm on Friday or any time on Saturday are non-peak time
- Changes from previous matrix:
 - 9:00 AM classes are now non-peak time
 - 3:30 PM classes are now peak time (one of the most popular class scheduling times)
 - 12:00 PM and 1:00 PM classes are now peak time (new flexibility to schedule MWF at 12pm & 1pm or MW 12:30-1:45pm – see below)
