#### **Chrome**

- 1. On your computer, open Chrome.
- 2. At the top right, click the More button: or: (on older versions)
- 3. Click **Settings** on the left menu.



4. At the bottom, click **Show advanced settings**.

5. Under "Privacy," click Content settings.




6. Under "Pop-ups," select Allow all sites to show pop-ups




### **Firefox**


- 1. Click the menu button
- 2. Click Options.



3. Select the **Content** panel.




4. Uncheck the box next to **Block pop-up windows**, in the Content panel below **Pop-ups**, to disable the pop-up blocker.



## Safari (on a Mac)

- 1. Open Safari.
- 2. Click **Safari** at the top left corner of the window.



3. Click **Preferences** in the drop-down menu.



4. Click the **Security** tab.



5. Under Web content, uncheck Block pop-up windows.




# Safari (iOS)

- 1. Launch Settings.
- 2. Tap Safari.



- 3. Under the General section, tap the toggle next to Block Pop-ups to enable or disable the pop-up blocker.
  - A green toggle indicates an enabled pop-up blocker.




• A gray toggle indicates a disabled pop-up blocker.




## **Internet Explorer**

4. On the **Privacy** tab, under Pop-up Blocker, select or clear the **Turn on Pop-up Blocker** check box, and then select **OK**.




## **Microsoft Edge**


1. Select the **More actions** button
